

GENERAL CLUB RULES & REGULATIONS **TENNIS COURTS AT TALAMORE ("THE CLUB")**



Court Reservations

- Reservations are highly encouraged and will have priority over those that 'walk on'
- Those who did not reserve court time will have to vacate the court if a reservation is booked. Please see a staff member if any assistance is needed.
- You may reserve a court up to 7 days in advance and for a maximum of 2 hours.
- If you are not going to be able to make a reserved time, please delete your reservation as soon as possible.
- IT IS AGAINST POLICY TO BOOK ANOTHER COURT TIME WITH YOUR PLAYING PARTNER OR GROUP TO CREATE A MATCH LONGER THAN 90 MINUTES.
- Courts are for Members only. Guests must be accompanied by a Member and are allowed on a limited basis. No more than 1 guest per Member & 2 total per group is permitted. Staff will disallow guests to those who take advantage of the above policy.
- Courts are available seasonally till dusk. The courts will open in early April (actual opening date is based on our tennis contractor's schedule) and will close in late-Fall.

Court Maintenance, Etiquette/Rules

- Routine maintenance of the courts will be provided by our grounds crew at different times/days throughout the season. The Courts will be closed during for a short period of time during any routine maintenance.
- Members who use the courts are REQUIRED to care for them upon completion of play. Such care would include sweeping the lines; brushing the courts; throwing away trash; organizing the sitting area; etc..
- Members and/or their children who do not adhere to the tennis parameters will have their tennis privileges suspended. The club is committed to administering these rules and regulations as a courtesy to the Membership and to prevent damage to the courts.
- The courts are not a 'playground' and are for use by recreational and serious tennis players only.
- Please wear appropriate tennis attire while on the court. Shirts, shoes, and athletic shorts/pants must be always worn. Street clothes and pool attire are not allowed
- While waiting for your current time, be courteous to the games taking place and wait outside the fence. Give the current players on court a 'courtesy heads-up' 5 minutes before your scheduled time to allow the current players to finish their game and move off the court on time.
- Players' family members should watch their match from outside the fence. This can be a distraction to the opponent.
- If you are watching from outside the fence, please keep noises to an appropriate level and respect members who are playing.
- No profanities, yelling, or screaming at any time on the court.
- Cell phone should be silenced and no loud music or profanity
- Courts are to be used for tennis. No pickleball on the courts.
- Courts may be used by the Club with other functions.
- Please keep the courts clean by picking up all balls and throwing away any trash.
- Do not retrieve your ball from another court while their point is in progress. Please wait until they finish their point.
